ORDER:-

In the circumstances reported by the Director, Welfare of Disabled & Senior Citizens, Hyderabad in the letters 2nd read above, Government after careful examination of the matter hereby make the following amendment to the G.O.Ms.No.23, Department for Women, Children, Disabled & Senior Citizens (DW), dated: 26-05-2011.

AMENDMENT

In the said G.O., Illustration 1 for Para 6 (iv) shall be substituted, with the following namely:-

- In the case of 6th roster point fixed for Blindness or Low (a) Vision (Woman), if Woman candidate with Blindness or Low Vision is not available in the initial recruitment year, the Vacancy shall be filled up by the male candidates with Blindness or Low Vision without carrying the vacancy forward to the next year. If Women or Male candidates with Blindness or Low vision are not available in the initial recruitment year, the vacancy shall be carried forward to the succeeding recruitment year for being filled up firstly by Women with Blindness or Low vision.
- If Women with Blindness or Low vision in that succeeding (b) recruitment year are also not available, the vacancy shall be filled up by the Male candidates with Blindness or Low Vision. If Women or Male candidates with Blindness or Low Vision are not available in such succeeding recruitment year also, the post may first be notified for Hearing Impaired candidate (being next category in the roster and if no such candidates comes forward it may be notified for Locomotor Disability or cerebral palsy (being the next category in the roster);

2. The General Administration (Ser.A) Department shall issue necessary amendments to the A.P.State & Subordinate Service Rules, 1996 accordingly.

3. All the Department of Secretariat, Heads of Departments and all officers concerned are requested to implement the above orders.
